Dear brothers and sisters,

We continue our reflections on the Five Precepts of the Church with the fourth being "to abstain from eating meat and to observe the days of fasting established by the Church."

Fasting is an ancient spiritual practice of our Faith. By either completely abstaining from a certain food or activity for a time, or by moderating our consumption, we allow ourselves to focus on our spiritual life. Fasting is the denying our physical appetites so as to refocus our energy toward spiritual ones.

Throughout the Church liturgical year, we have certain times when we are asked to fast. We are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, the Fridays of Lent, and on Good Friday. We should also make every Friday of the year a time of penance, either in the ordinary way of not eating meat, or by some other sacrifice. We do this to honor the Sacrifice of our Lord, who gave his life for us. In addition to this, we are called to practice the Eucharistic Fast of not eating for one hour before receiving Holy Communion.



Isaiah 6:8

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Our readings today remind us of the great privilege we have in calling ourselves both children and disciples of the Most High God.

The First Reading from Isaiah describes a vision of the prophet in which angels surround the Lord proclaiming, "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts! All the earth is filled with his glory!" Our God invites us to such deep intimacy and friendship with Him that sometimes we can forget just how majestic and unspeakably holy He truly is.

In the Gospel passage, from Luke, Jesus instructs Simon to lower his nets for a catch despite an unsuccessful night of fishing. Peter is skeptical but obeys and is amazed at the catch of fish that he makes. He kneels down before Jesus in astonishment.

This sense of awe and reverence before God should motivate us to

deepen our stewardship way of life. As we contemplate the holiness of God, we come to a heightened awareness of what a privilege it is that He has chosen to include us in His work of spreading the Gospel to others through the grateful sharing of the gifts He has given us. Aware of this privilege, we will then make the words of Isaiah our own: "Here I am Lord, send me! ©*Catholic Stewardship Consultants*




