
We ask that all faithful parishioners complete a Commitment Card. A card will be included in the brochure mailing for you to:

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Jesus addresses His disciples saying, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me." We are Jesus' disciples, and He is speaking those same words to us here and now.



Living a life of discipleship is not always easy. It requires us to be imitators of Christ — who suffered, died, and rose from the dead out of total love for each one of us. This means we are called to share in Christ's sufferings by taking up our cross and following Him daily.

But what does this look like in our day-to-day lives?

We can start by making a firm resolution to follow Christ today, here and now, and renewing that resolution each day when

we rise. This requires time with Him each day — speaking and listening.

We should also strive to pick up our crosses each day with Christ by our side. Our cross might be suffering from an illness, fighting an addiction, a day of screaming kids, or a period where things just don't seem to go our way. Instead of avoiding these sufferings or complaining about them, we are called to carry them with Christ, allowing Him to transform us through them.

If we live life constantly focused on us, we will ultimately lose ourselves, but if we surrender our lives for Christ and His mission, we will gain eternal life and become more alive than we could have ever imagined, "For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and that of the gospel will save it." This takes daily commitment and requires endurance in our faith, which can only be done through active discipleship.

PRIEST RETIREMENT COLLECTION & LUNCHEON

Our priests have dedicated their lives to serving others. They have been with us and those we love for many of life's most precious moments, from birth to death, showing us the love and compassion of God. They have baptized us, taught us, preached the Gospel to us, and led our parish communities. They have heard our sins, blessed us with absolution, and brought us the Eucharistic gift of Christ Himself. They have witnessed our weddings, comforted us in illness, officiated our funerals, and always been there, in both our times of distress and our moments of celebration. In their retirement years, these men of God need and deserve our help.

As in 2023, the money raised this year will be directed to repairing and renovating the Serra Clergy House in San Mateo, where several of our retired Priests reside. Thanks to the generosity provided in last year's Luncheon and Special Collection, a new roof has been installed, the irrigation system has been repaired and the glass patio doors have been replaced. This increases the safety and security of our retired Priests.

Other completed projects refreshed the common areas and enhanced the dining room. Dinner is the primary gathering time for our retired Priests; they enjoy the updated and more comfortable setting.

The funds raised in 2024 will fund seismic and electrical panel upgrades already underway. Your generosity will also enable us to paint the Clergy House, revitalize landscaping, and install double-paned windows, among other projects.
